Position Overview

The Skagway Child Care Council (SCCC) is seeking a motivated **Cohort Leader** to guide students through the Early Childhood Education (ECE) Workforce Development Program, funded by the Innovate Grant. The Cohort Leader will play a critical role in recruiting, mentoring, and supporting participants as they pursue coursework and career pathways in Early Childhood Education.

Key Responsibilities

- **Recruit & Enroll Students:** Promote the program, assist with forms, class registration, and book/supply purchases.
 - **Mentorship & Support:** Lead weekly cohort meetings, provide one-on-one support, and motivate students to stay on track.
 - **Academic & Professional Guidance:** Offer feedback on coursework, connect students with tutors and resources, and encourage career development.
 - **Liaison Role:** Serve as the primary connection between students and SCCC.
 - **Program Coordination & Reporting:** Track student progress, manage stipends, submit monthly updates, and provide a final report on outcomes and recommendations.
